Dear Parent/Carer

Free School Meals and Clothing Allowances (2025/2026)

Orkney Islands Council provides assistance with free school meals and clothing allowances to families who are in receipt of certain benefits. The Scottish Government sets the eligibility criteria and for academic year 2025/26 you may be entitled to support if you are in receipt of one of the following:

- Income Support.
- Pension Credit.
- · Income-based Job Seeker's Allowance.
- · Any income related element of Employment and Support Allowance.
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- Universal Credit with a monthly earned income of not more than £850.
- Scottish Child Payment (P6 and P7 only) Not eligible for clothing allowance.

Carers of a Looked After Child may be eligible, without the need for an income assessment.

Applications should ideally be submitted by 31 July 2025 to ensure that arrangements are in place for the new academic year, starting on 19 August 2025.
