COSTUMES

We are looking for each child to have:

- a costume of joggy bottoms (the baggier the better) in neutral colours (black, grey, brown, yellow)
- a self-coloured colourful t-shirt (long-sleeved if possible)
- either a waistcoat or an old shirt of someone's that we can cut the sleeves off to make into a waistcoat.

While we are not expecting every child to be able to provide this, if you do have all or some of these items please send them in with a plastic bag we can store them in.

We don't want anybody to go out and buy anything, therefore we ask that you only provide what you can (and if that is nothing that is fine). If you don't have things that fit your child but would fit someone else or have spare items you don't need we would gratefully receive them.

If you want anything returned to you please make sure you put your or your child's name on it, otherwise we may cut it up to add to other costumes.

If anyone has pieces of cloth that may be suitable for making into princes' outfits (think shiny, bright and colourful) and you no longer need them we would be delighted to have those too.

Also if you have a particular interest in this type of thing we would always appreciate helpers to get them all together. Please make your interest known to Shona or class teachers.

Please bring in what you can offer as soon as possible, we would like all costumes ready to wear by 7 December.

Tickets

Orphir Community School Parent Forum have decided for this school year that there will not be a set price on the tickets for any ticketed event in school - tickets are required for numbers but entry is then by donations for those who feel able to contribute at this time.

A form for each family to complete requesting number of tickets will go home with the children on Friday 25 November. Once family tickets have been issued, tickets will go on general release and can be collected in advance from the school office. They cannot be reserved for collection on the night.

Tickets will be printed shortly for the shows. These are as follows:

There will be a dress rehearsal to which folk can attend <u>only</u> if they can't attend either of the evening performances. Wednesday 14 December, doors open 1.30pm, show starts 2.00pm. Again tickets would need to be requested for these for sake of numbers. Donations at the door as with the other performances.

There is an expectation that all children (Nursery-P7) will be on stage for all 3 performances – if that is not possible, do let the child(ren)'s class teacher know asap.

The children are studying the lines so that (on the whole) there are 2 children playing each of the main parts in case of illness. Both evening performances will be recorded. Where there are 2 siblings in 'main parts' they will perform the same night.

Raffle Prizes

Earlier in the year the Parent Council kindly made the generous decision to not charge for ticketed events in school this year. This is a gesture that we very much appreciate and is incredibly generous and ensures that all of our events are open and accessible to all. We would however welcome any donations of raffle prizes for both our evening performances of Aladdin to help us raise a peedie bit of money to pop back into our school fund. If you can spare anything that could be raffled off then please hand this into Shona in the school office by Friday 9 December. If you are donating foodstuffs, please do be mindful on the dates.
